LEARNING AREA 1

At the end of term 3 LA1 had a bit of spare time on our hands, so we headed out into the yard to forage for twigs to make birds nests.

We started by using food dye and water in green and blue to make paint for the background. Then we made bird eggs out of various colours of modelling clay. Finally, we glued our twigs and eggs on our paper, with the finishing touch being a colourful leaf.











LEARNING AREA 2

LA2 students are learning about area and perimeter in maths. They have calculated the size of shapes and objects using area and perimeter in centimetres and metres. Students were asked to measure and make 1 m2 using newspaper.



LA2 have also been busy learning how to write procedural text. In the morning, Team 1 wrote "How to Make a Milkshake" and Team 2 wrote "How to Make Fairy Bread". In the afternoon, the students followed their procedural text and made Milkshakes and Fairy Bread. Delicious!

Our Wergaia Elder Aunty Marjorie Pickford has been helping them with translations and use of local symbols. All the students will receive a t-shirt which has been funded by the DASH program.


